## Foundation Stage

**A choice of sessions linked to the Foundation Stage learning goals.**

### **Growing up!**

Suitable for 4 / 5 year olds. A look at animal babies and how they grow up! A chance to see some animals up close and join the fun in this interactive session.

**Learning Goals:** Knowledge & Understanding of the World, Personal, Social & Emotional Development.

### **How many legs?**

Come and meet some of our smaller residents and find out a little bit about who and what they are! This session will help the children to compare and contrast and use simple vocabulary such as numbers, big, small, long, short etc

**Covers:** Knowledge and understanding of the world, Numeracy, Personal, social and emotional development.

### **Shapes and Colours**

An introduction to the shapes and colours of the animal kingdom. The sessions look at patterns, textures and colours with a chance to meet a range of friendly creatures!

**Covers:** Knowledge and understanding of the world, Numeracy, Personal, social and emotional development.

### **Story telling**

Join us for a special story telling session involving a chance to meet some of the characters!

**Covers:** Personal, social and emotional development.

### **Where do you live?**

Take a trip around the world and meet some of creatures from different habitats. Find out about where they live, what they look like - and even what they feel like!

**Covers:** Knowledge and understanding of the world.

### **Topic of your choice**

If you would like a topic to fit in with schemes of work or special projects, please feel free to contact the education team who can tailor any session to suit your needs. (Examples of previous sessions include: 'Mini-beasts' and 'Jungle animals'.)
