



HANDS-ON LEARNING 2011 PROGRAMME

Key Stage

1 & 2

A choice of 8 sessions all linked to the National Curriculum.

All sessions involve the chance to meet *live animals* and see animal bio-facts.

The African Adventure!

Come with us on an incredible journey around some of the National Parks of Africa! Become an explorer and track the wildlife of forests, savannahs and deserts and get hands-on with some of Africa's animals.

Covers: Life Processes, Variation & Classification, Living things in their environment (Adaptation, Feeding relationships, Micro-organisms), Care for the Environment, Geography (Habitats), Citizenship.

Animals & Us

Based around the citizenship curriculum and scheme of work, as well as bringing in conservation themes. Responsibility, respect and healthy living are all visited in this lesson - as well as a chance to meet some of our furry, slimy or scaly friends!

Covers: Citizenship, Life Processes, Variation & Classification, Care for the environment.

Animals and their Homes

Travel the world and find out how different animals are suited to their habitats - with a chance to meet a few.

Covers: Life Processes, Variation & Classification, Living things in their environment (Adaptation, Feeding relationships, Micro-organisms), Care for the Environment, Geography (Habitats).

Animal Babies & Growth

Learn about different animal babies and how they grow. Meet a few animals and see amazing animal biofacts!

Covers: Life Processes, Humans & animals (Growth & Reproduction), Variation & Classification, Citizenship.

Dinnertime!

Find out all about Dinnertime in the animal kingdom, who eats what - or who eats who! A basic introduction to classification, anatomy, physiology and healthy living, with a close up look at skulls and teeth.

Covers: Life Processes, Humans & animals (Nutrition), Green plants, Variation & Classification, Health, Citizenship (Healthy lifestyle).

Marvellous Movement

A chance to compare and contrast and to find out about basic classification and anatomy. During the session you will meet some 'moving' creatures and see some 'marvellous' bio-facts.

Covers: Life Processes, Humans & animals (circulation, movement), Green plants, Variation & Classification, Citizenship.

Noisy Nature! This new session looks at animal communication and gives everyone the chance to get noisy! It also involves getting up close with some noisy nature and colourful creatures.

Covers: Life Processes, Living things & their environment (Adaptation). Also links to English: Speaking & Listening, Drama and Music.

ACTION SAFARI!

This outdoor guided tour will take you around part of the park with plenty of information, fun and games. Topics available; 1) Monkeys, mongoose and more, 2) Plains of Africa – Veggies and Meat eaters.



Sessions are charged at £20 and include an education pack and a teacher's pack. Sessions last approx 45 minutes and can seat up to 30 children
